ABSTRACT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- Abstracts must be typed in English
- Abstracts are typed in Arial font size 10 with single spacing, all typing must fit within the lines (Justify) and leave no margin at the top of left side.
- Title, Author's names and Institutional Affiliation:
 - The title should be entirely in Capital letters
 - All authors should give all names & presenting author's name must be underline
 - Institutional Affiliation city and country are necessary and must follow directly after the name of the authors.
 - Type the names all of authors immediately below the Title, a blank line is not necessary.
- Place single blank line between the names of authors to start the beginning of the text.
- Maximum words should be at least 100 words and not exceed 300 words (not including title and authors information).
- The purpose of the study, methodology, results and conclusion should be clearly stated as the starting paragraph and the text are typed immediately below. Place a single blank line between paragraph.
- References should be avoided.
- Abbreviations should be used only for common terms. For uncommon terms, the abbreviations should be given in brackets after the first full use of the word.
- Do not use table of graphics in the Abstracts. All data must be in narrative form.

WITHDRAWAL/CHANGES & FULL PAPER SUBMISSION DEADLINE

- Revised abstracts must be one time only and should be clearly stated as the subject of email and received by **01 JUNE 2009**. Withdrawal/changes will not be possible after the above mentioned date.
- The AOCNR Scientific Review Committee will pre-evaluate all Abstract submission along with attached Full Paper of the mentioned Abstract, therefore Presenting authors must further submit its full paper before **01 JUNE 2009** by email only at: secraocnr@yahoo.co.id

Bali, as the 'Island of the Gods' there is the combination of the friendly people, the natural attractions, the great variety of things to see and do, the year-round pleasant climate, and the absence of security problems. And then there is Bali's special 'magic', which is difficult to explain. The moment you feel the magic of this island, you are addicted for the rest of your life.

CLIMATE

You can expect pleasant day temperature between 20 – 33 degrees Celsius or 68 – 93 degrees Fahrenheit year-around. From June-September the humidity is low, and it can be quite cool in the evenings. The clothing necessary for outdoor purpose during this weather is light and thin clothing. Casual dress is acceptable for most situations and occasions but some establishments may require a more formal dress code, i.e. Congress Dinner

PASSPORT AND VISA

Any foreign visitors who want to visit Indonesia must have a valid passport at least for another 6 months. The government of Indonesia has changed its visa policy for foreign visitors effective February 1st 2004 by visiting Indonesia without any visa for nationals of following countries and territories: Brunei Darussalam, Chile, Hongkong, Macau, Malaysia, Morocco, Peru, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam. Citizens of the above countries will be issued on arrival a stay permit for 30 days free of charge upon presentation of a passport. This stay permit can not be extended or converted into another type of visa. Visa on Arrival (VoA) facility is now available for 21 of countries (please contact the nearest Indonesian Consulate for the visa application and further information), which valid 7-30 days upon arrival by air in few international airports. A 7-days visa costs USD 10 and 30-days visa costs USD25.



Visitor INFORMATION



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AIRPORT TAX

A domestic passenger service charge is around Rp. 25.000 - Rp. 30.000 and should be paid during check in the airport.

CURRENCY & AUTOMATIC TELLER MACHINES

Indonesian Rupiah (IDR) is the monetary unit in Indonesia. Notes come in denominations of Rp. 100.000, Rp. 50.000, Rp. 20.000, Rp. 10.000, Rp. 5.000, Rp. 1.000. Foreign currency and traveler's cheques can be converted into Rupiah at authorized money changers or banks, however some banks do not have foreign exchange dealing on Saturdays. The exchange rate is subjected to market fluctuations approximately Rp. 12.000 - 13.000. Passports are required when cashing in travelers' cheques. A nominal commissions may be charged. Many places accept credit card such as Visa and Master however we strongly advice. ATMs are everywhere, which may connects to international banking networks, so you can withdraw cash in Rupiah from your home account. Look for those affiliated with your own ATM network, noted by signage on your card and the compatible ATM.

ELECTRICITY & TELEPHONE

Electricity voltage is 220 voltage. There are two mobile phone networks: GSM & CDMA. To make international calls, the access codes is +62 and Bali access code is +361

TIPPING

Most larger hotels and restaurants automatically add government tax and service charge of up to 21percents to the bill. Tipping is unusual and you are not compelled to tip. However, if you like the service a tip 10-15 percents is appreciated. Carry small change with you as taxi drivers often have none. Airport or hotels porters expect tip per bag depending on the size and weight.

AROUND BALI

The shoppers among you will find Bali a treasure house of handicrafts and fine works or art. Those of you keen on delving into the island's fascinating culture will have plenty opportunities, as colorful ceremonies and traditional performances occur with the regularity of sunrise.

DEPARTURE

Reconfirm your airline reservation 24 hours prior to departure. Not all international airlines require reconfirmation, but check your flight. Indonesian carriers frequently overbook due to holiday seasons in June-July. Make sure you get the computer print-out from the airline office/travel agent that says you have seat. Seat assignments can not always be arranged in advanced. Arrive at the airport two hours prior to departure. An international departure tax is required in Rupiah as well as departure tax for domestic destination. Residents pay an additional fiscal tax.
